

## Recipe(Class4)

#### **BOILED PINEAPPLE CAKE RECIPE**

1 x 425g can crushed pineapple 4 oz margarine

4 oz soft brown sugar 4 oz chopped glace cherries

12 oz sultanas1 level tsp bicarb2 beaten eggs4 oz SR flour4 oz plain flourPinch salt

#### **METHOD**

- 1. Simmer the pineapple in a large saucepan
- 2. Add margarine, brown sugar, chopped cherries and sultanas and simmer for 15 minutes, then add bicarb
- 3. Allow the mixture to cool
- 4. Beat the eggs and add to the mixture, then fold in the sieved flour and salt
- 5. Grease a 2 lb loaf tin, line and bake at 165°C, 325°F or gas mark 3 for 1½ hours
