Recipe (Class4)

GLUTEN FREE LEMON DRIZZLE CAKE

Ingredients:

175g caster sugar

175g Softened butter

3 lemons (used in both cake and drizzle)

For the syrup

100 g caster sugar

Juice of 2 lemons

3 medium eggs

100g gluten free self raising flour

75g Ground almonds

For white glaze icing

120g icing sugar

Lemon juice

Zest for decoration optional

METHOD

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C/160°C Fan/Gas Mark 4.
2. Grease and line 2lb loaf tin
3. Beat together the butter and caster sugar.
4. Add the grated lemon zest of 2 lemons and beat until light and fluffy.
5. Add the eggs (add these one at a time and beat each thoroughly until combined before adding the next).
6. Sift in your gluten free flour and fold it in.
7. Fold in your ground almonds.
8. Spoon the mixture into the prepared tin.
9. Bake for about 45 to 50 minutes until golden and cooked through.
10. To make the syrup, gently heat the sugar in the lemon juice until melted, boil for 15 seconds.

11. Remove the cake from the oven, but leave in the tin
12. Poke holes all over the top of the cake (whilst still hot) and gradually pour over the drizzle.
13. Allow to fully cool in the tin before removing.
14. Once the cake is cold drizzle the icing over the top and decorate with lemon zest (optional)
